He said the RFP will be sent out in December and was looking to see what direction or vision the committee has for the community center building. Mayor Ledesma mentioned that a large gym was interested in coming into Soledad. He said that the community is changing and different types of recreational programs would definitely be great for the city. He'd like to see a variety of recreational programs other than just sports.

City Manager McHatten mentioned that senior centers are being missed and no programs are available for them.

Mayor Pro Tem Chavez said that Watsonville has a Neighborhood Services department that has worked very well for them in working with the community and its needs.

Citizen Representative Ramirez said that the Community Center seemed very expensive for event rentals in comparison to others.
