Resolution declaring result of Election.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the city of Soledad, on Monday, the 12th., day of April, 1926, as required by law,

AND WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given, that voting precinct was properly established, that election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished, and that in all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the general laws of the State governing elections in cities of the sixth class,

AND WHEREAS, the board of trustees of said city met at the council chamber of the board on Monday, the 19th., day of April, 1926, to canvass the returns of said election and install the newly elected officers, as a result of which the board finds
