

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION, No. 11

WHEREAS, the Soledad Union Grammar School District, a public corporation, has filed its petition herein showing that it is the owner of those certain Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Block Q, and Lots 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 of Block P of the City of Soledad, said Lots bordering on either side of Encinal Street of the said City from North Street on the north to Market Street on the south, and further showing that the public interest and convenience demand that the said Encinal Street be closed up from North Street to Market Street and praying that the said street be so closed up;

AND IT APPEARING that the public interest and convenience demand that, and will be enhanced if, the said Encinal Street be closed up from the said North Street to the said Market Street;

RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Council of the City of Soledad to order the following improvement in the said City to be made, to-wit:

THAT all that part of Encinal Street in the City of Soledad, as per Map of Soledad, compiled by St. John Fox, refiled February 1st. 1877, in Map Book One, Cities and Towns, in the office of the County Recorder of Monterey County, California, extending from North Street of the said City on the north to Market Street of the said City on the south be closed up in whole and cease to be a public right of way;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any and all further steps and acts necessary to close up the aforesaid part of the said street be taken and performed pursuant to the provisions and requirements of Act 4945, commonly known as the Street Opening Act of 1889, and entitled "An Act to provide for the laying out, opening, extending, widening, straightening, or closing up in whole or in part any street, square, lane, alley, court or place within municipalities, and to condemn and acquire any and all land and property necessary or convenient for that purpose";
