A RESOLUTION CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SOLEDAD ON TUESDAY, THE 12th DAY OF APRIL, 1938.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD, CALIFORNIA, that in accordance with law a general municipal election will be held in said city on Tuesday, the 12th day of April, 1938, for the election of two members of the City Council, a City Clerk and a Treasurer of said city for the full term of four years each; that there will be one voting precinct for the purpose of holding said election consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts duly established for holding state or county elections in said city as follows:

That for the purposes of said general municipal election all of the territory lying within the corporate limits of said city of Soledad be, and it is hereby, consolidated into one voting precinct, namely, Consolidated Voting Precinct "A", comprising the consolidation of all of the regular election precincts established for holding state or county elections in said city.

That the polling place of said Consolidated Voting Precinct "A" shall be at American Legion Hall in said city.

That for the purpose of holding said general municipal election, a board of election for said consolidated voting precinct shall, pursuant to law, consist of one inspector, one judge and two clerks, who shall have charge of such election in and for said consolidated voting precinct for which they are appointed, and the following named persons are hereby designated and appointed as the election officers to conduct such election in the capacities hereinafter set forth, each of said persons being a resident and a registered qualified elector of the consolidated voting precinct from which he is appointed and appearing upon the register of applicants for such positions of file with the county clerk of the County of Monterey, State of California, wherein said city is situate, to-wit;

For said Consolidated Voting Precinct "A":

That the compensation of each of said election officers is hereby fixed at the sum of \$ 4.00 for acting in such capacity at said election.

That the polls for said election shall be and remain open from the hour of 10 o'clock a. m. of said day to the hour of 7 o'clock p. m. of the same day continuously (except as provided by section 1164 of the Political Code of the State of California) when said polls shall be closed.

That the official ballots to be used at said election shall conform to the laws of the State of California in relation thereto;

That it shall not be necessary to print or mail sample ballots or polling place cards for such election;

That the city clerk shall publish a list of the names of the nominees for said respective offices in alphabetical order and a list of said offices to which they have been nominated as provided by law;

That the city clerk shall procure the necessary voting booths and see that they are properly erected; he shall also have the necessary ballots printed and secure the necessary ballot boxes, stamps, ink pads, voting lists, rosters, instruction cards, affidavits of registration and indexes thereto, tally lists, returns, envelopes and all the necessary supplies and see that they are properly distributed to the polling place and voting booth prior to the opening of the poll on the day of said election.

That the "Soledad Bee" a weekly newspaper of general circulation printed, published and circulated in said city and the official newspaper thereof is hereby designated as the newspaper in which all notices relating to said election shall be published.

That in all respects not otherwise provided for herein said general municipal election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the general laws of the State of California governing elections in cities of the sixth class.

That the city council of said city shall meet on the first Monday after said election, to-wit, the 18th day of April, 1938, at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m. in the meeting room of said council at the City Hall of said city to canvass the returns of said election and install the newly elected officers.

Said council shall declare elected the persons having the highest number of votes for each office upon the completion of said canvass and before installing the new officers said council shall pass a resolution reciting the fact of said election and such other matters as are by law required to be therein enumerated;

That said city clerk be, and he is hereby, ordered to give notice
over

of said election as is required by law.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD APPROVING MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR EXPENDITURE OF 1/4 CENT GAS TAX ALLOCATED FOR STREETS OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE
