RESOLUTION DIRECTING WORK TO BE DONE
UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE ENGINEER

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad, that
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad did on the 16th day of February, 1949, pass its resolution ordering certain work and improvements to be done and made pursuant to proceedings taken under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, and which improvements are described in Resolution of Intention No. 241-6, reference to said resolution being hereby expressly made for all further particulars; and
