

RESOLUTION NO. 2636

A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 1997
STREET PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
PAVEX CONSTRUCTION COMPANY
TOTALING \$650,850.20 TO BE
FUNDED FROM THE LOCAL
TRANSPORTATION FUND,
GAS TAX FUND AND
THE WATER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad has accepted bids for the construction of the 1997 Street Project; and

WHEREAS, the bid in the amount of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$650,850.20) from Pavex Construction was the lowest most responsible bid submitted for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid in the amount of \$650,850.20 submitted by Pavex Construction Company is hereby declared the lowest most responsible bid.

Section 2: That all other bids are hereby rejected.


