

RESOLUTION NO. 2638

**A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 1997
WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
WITH MONTEREY PENINSULA ENGINEERING
TOTALING \$62,950, TO BE FUNDED FROM
THE WATER RESERVE IMPACT FEES**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad has accepted bids for the construction of the 1997 Water System Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the bid in the amount of Seventy-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$77,450) from Monterey Peninsula Engineering was the lowest most responsible bid submitted for the project.

WHEREAS, work to be performed includes: installation of two prefabricated chlorination buildings at existing City wells #6 and #7; demolition and abandonment of water well #1; construction of a water well blowoff, electrical, control and miscellaneous appurtenances per the Contract Documents.

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 1997-98 the City budgeted \$14,500 for such improvements and the balance of \$62,950 to be funded from the Water Reserve Impact Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


- Section 1:** That the bid in the amount of \$77,450 submitted by Monterey Peninsula Engineering is hereby declared the lowest most responsible bid.
- Section 2:** That all other bids are hereby rejected.
- Section 3:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to issue a "Notice to Proceed" to Monterey Peninsula Engineering, upon fulfillment of all requirements relating to the commencement of work.
