

RESOLUTION NO. 2639

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PAINT STRIPER
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,274.13 FROM THE
FY 1997-98 STREET FUND BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad has accepted bids for the purchase of a paint striper machine; and

WHEREAS, the bid in the amount of Six Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Four Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$6,274.13) from Pervo Paint Company was the lowest most responsible bidder submitted for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid in the amount of \$6,274.13 submitted by Pervo Paint Company is hereby declared the lowest most responsible bidder.

Section 2: That all other bids are hereby rejected:


Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase a paint striper machine in the amount of \$6,274.13.
