**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
DECLARING UTILITY EQUIPMENT SURPLUS AND
DONATING EQUIPMENT TO A NON-PROFIT
AGENCY**

WHEREAS, Government State Code Section 37350 provides for the ability of cities to dispose of property for the common benefit of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has accumulated material that is surplus property;
and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad declares as surplus property items from the Utility Department and City property; and

WHEREAS, the surplus equipment are broken Water Meters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs with staff that the surplus items will be donated to Red Cliff Arts and Crafts, a non-profit agency.


