

RESOLUTION NO. 2647**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE
CALIFORNIA WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD FOR A
1996/97 TIRE RECYCLING GRANT**

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted Assembly Bill 1843 (W. Brown, Chapter 974, Statutes of 1989) that provides grants to local governments, businesses and non-profit organizations for the purpose of diverting tires from landfill disposal by fostering new business enterprises and encouraging cooperative local government programs; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies, businesses and non-profit organizations under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Integrated Waste Management Board require the applicant to certify by resolution approval of the application before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad will enter into the agreement with the State of California for development of the track project authorizing the Soledad Unified School District to execute and administer the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad Unified School District has certified a mitigated Negative Declaration with the development of the entire Soledad High School site, including the development of a Track and Field Stadium; and

WHEREAS, the proposed track facility will be available and benefit the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad Unified School District has received numerous letters from community organizations in support of the proposed track project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed \$50,000 grant will fund a portion of the overall \$125,000 and recycle the equivalent of 8,100 passenger car tires, assisting in reducing the overall waste stream to local landfills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad authorizes the submittal of an application to the California Waste Management Board for a 1996/97 Tire Recycling Grant. The City Council of the City of Soledad hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute in the name of the Soledad Unified School District all necessary applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.
