

RESOLUTION NO. 2654

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SOLEDAD MAKING MINOR CHANGES TO THE CITY
OF SOLEDAD CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE**

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 8100, et. seq., requires every State or local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad, by way of Resolution No. 2551, has previously adopted a Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has determined that Appendix A of Resolution No. 2551 requires minor modification in order to reflect recent staffing changes in the City of Soledad.

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED, that:

- 1) Appendix A of Resolution No. 2551 is hereby amended, so as to include the positions of Assistant City Manager and Fire Chief. Amended Appendix A, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A," shall replace and supersede previous Appendix A.
- 2) All persons holding designated positions identified in Amended Appendix A shall file statements of economic interest pursuant to the Conflict of Interest Code.

The city manager shall forward a copy of this determination to the Fair Political Practices Commission. Nothing herein excuses any such consultant from any other provision of this Conflict of Interest Code.
