

RESOLUTION NO. 2680**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
OPPOSING ELIMINATION OF VEHICLE LICENSE FEE (VLF)
REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF SOLEDAD**

WHEREAS, the Vehicle License Fee (VLF) represents 27% of all Soledad General Fund revenue and its loss would have a serious effect on current City services and planned Quality of Life projects in the areas of Police, Fire, and Parks Services; and

WHEREAS, over 90% of Vehicle License Fee Revenue in California flows to cities and counties and not to the State; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the City of Soledad to take a position on this very important issue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City of Soledad is opposed to the proposed elimination of Vehicle License Fee Revenues and that its members work with the League of California Cities and other City and County groups throughout California to oppose these proposals.
