

RESOLUTION NO 1849

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
PROCLAIMING MAY 14, 1988 AS SPARTAN CLEANUP DAY

WHEREAS, the Gonzales Union High School District has requested that the Soledad City Council proclaim May 14, 1988 as Spartan Cleanup Day; and,

WHEREAS, on Spartan Cleanup Day the students of Gonzales High School will go forth into the Soledad Community to pick up trash, remove graffitti and perform other public spirited good deeds; and,

WHEREAS, by ridding the City of these nuisances, the students will in time develop a keen sense of awareness that maintaining the City free from litter is a public responsibility and thus every citizens's duty; and,

WHEREAS, the students in their cleanup effort will be sponsored by private individuals and organizations thereby raising funds for extracurricular athletics.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Soledad at a regular meeting duly held on the 27th day of April, 1988, by the following vote


