

RESOLUTION NO. 1884

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE
GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON
NOVEMBER 8, 1988

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, the 8th of November, 1988, a general election was held in the City of Soledad in accordance with law, and the votes therefrom were received and canvassed, and the results thereof were ascertained, determined and declared valid in all respects by the Monterey County Registrar of Voters as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the total number of votes cast at said election were 1100, computed by the Monterey County Registrar of Voters as follows:

TOTAL VOTES CAST	1,100


Section 2. That the following persons received the following votes for the office of City Councilmembers:


<u>NAME</u>	<u>VOTES</u>
