

RESOLUTION NO. 1904

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD REQUESTING THAT THE HONORABLE GEORGE DEUKMEJIAN, GOVERNOR OF CALIFORNIA, REINSTATE THE FUNDING NEEDED TO CONTINUE THE ADULT INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM CONDUCTED BY THE GONZALES UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Gonzales Union High School District Independent Study Program has operated successfully in the City of Soledad, California for the past four years, and;

WHEREAS, each year the program has graduated more students, last year graduating 39, thereby helping the community in terms of not only the educational level of community members, the self-esteem of members but also the employability of community members, and;

WHEREAS, during this current year the Gonzales Union High School District Independent Study Program has enrolled over 200 of our citizens over the age of 19, and;

WHEREAS the Gonzales Union High School District Adult Program is capped and cannot enroll students into diploma program.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Soledad City Council urges the Honorable George Deukmejian, Governor of California to reinstate the funding needed to continue the Independent Study Programs serving students 19 years of age and older.
