

## RESOLUTION NO. 1925

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE  
UNIFORM DISTRICT ELECTION HELD  
ON THE 7TH DAY OF NOVEMBER,  
1989

WHEREAS, Article XXXIV of the Constitution of the State of California requires that a low rent housing project to be developed, constructed or acquired in the City of Soledad by any state public body must be submitted to and approved by a majority of the qualified electors of said City voting upon such issue; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Redevelopment Agency of the City of Soledad has proposed to develop, construct or acquire a low rent housing project for senior citizens within the meaning of Article XXXIV in the City of Soledad; and,

WHEREAS, for the ease and convenience of the registered voters within the City and in order to take advantage of any possible reduction in election costs, it is desirable that said special municipal election be consolidated with the Uniform District Election to be held in the same territory on the 7th day of November, 1989.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In accordance with law, the City Council of the City of Soledad hereby calls for a special municipal election to be held in the City of Soledad on Tuesday, the 7th day of November, 1989, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City for their approval or rejection the following proposition:

SHALL THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD, WITH FEDERAL OR STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, OR WITH TAX INCREMENT FUNDS, OR BY ANY OTHER FINANCIAL MEANS EXCEPT FOR THE USE OF LOCAL TAXES, BE AUTHORIZED TO DEVELOP, CONSTRUCT OR ACQUIRE CONSISTENT WITH THE GENERAL PLAN, OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD NOT MORE THAN SIXTY (60) UNITS OF LOW RENT HOUSING FOR SENIOR CITIZENS CONSISTING OF STUDIO, ONE (1) AND TWO (2) BEDROOM UNITS WITHIN A BUILDING

OR BUILDINGS CONSISTING OF ONE (1) AND TWO (2) STORIES TO BE LOCATED ON AN APPROXIMATELY SEVEN (7) ACRE SITE IN THE CITY OF SOLEDAD GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY ANDALUCIA DRIVE, ON THE WEST BY METZ ROAD, ON THE SOUTH BY WALKER DRIVE AND ON THE EAST BY THE HOUSING TRACT GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE ANDALUCIA SUBDIVISION, WHICH SITE IS DESIGNATED FOR SAID RESIDENTIAL USE AND FOR WHICH APPROPRIATE AND ADEQUATE FACILITIES AND SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE?

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 23300, et seq. of the Elections Code, the special municipal election shall be consolidated with the Uniform District Elections to be held totally or partially within the boundaries of the City of Soledad on the same day, and the consolidation of such other election with this election is hereby authorized.

Section 3. Except as in this resolution otherwise specifically provided, all of the statutory functions and duties of the City Council and of the City Clerk with respect to said election are hereby delegated to the Registrar of Voters of the County of Monterey, who is authorized on behalf of the City of Soledad to publish all notices required by law; to select polling places and appoint elections officers; to determine the hours during which the polls will be open; to prepare and mail sample ballots; to prepare official ballots; to process absentee ballots; to conduct the official canvass of the ballots cast at said elections, and to do all other things required by law in connection with the conduct of said special municipal election.

Section 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 17050 of the Elections Code, all ballots cast in this special municipal election shall be tallied at a central place, to wit, the Elections Department of the County of Monterey located at 201 Main Street, Salinas, California. The Registrar of Voters shall conduct the official canvass, commencing on Wednesday, November 8th, 1989. The City Council shall meet at its usual meeting place on Tuesday, November 14, 1989 (being the first Tuesday after said election) or on the first Tuesday after the


Registrar of Voters has completed the official canvass. Said meeting to approve the canvass shall be set at the hour of 8:00 p.m. at which time the City Council will declare the result of said special municipal election.

Section 5. The Registrar of Voters is authorized to bill the City on a pro-rated basis, for any and all services associated with the election as so requested by the City of Soledad
