

RESOLUTION NO. 1938

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE FILING OF
APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT FUNDS UNDER
THE 1989 ROBERTI-Z'BERG-HARRIS
URBAN OPEN SPACE AND
RECREATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has enacted the 1989 Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Urban Open Space and Recreation Program, which provides funds to certain political subdivisions of the State of California for acquiring lands and for developing facilities to meet urban recreation needs; and,

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program, setting up necessary application by local agencies under the program; and,

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications prior to submission of said applications to the State; and,

WHEREAS, said applications contain a certification that the applicant will comply with all federal, state, and local environmental, public health, relocation, affirmative action, and clearinghouse requirements and all other appropriate codes, laws, and regulations prior to the expenditure of the grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified the "1989 Vosti Park Lighting Improvement Project" and the "1989 Little League Park Improvement Project" as two projects eligible for funding; and,

WHEREAS, the projects applied for under this program are of a high priority and satisfy the most urgent park and recreation needs, with emphasis on unmet needs in the most heavily populated areas of the City of Soledad;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to the rules and regulations of the 1989 Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Urban Open Space and Recreation Program, the City of Soledad authorizes the filing of separate applications for the "1989 Vosti Park Lighting Improvements Project" and the "1989 Little League Park Improvements Project".

Section 2. That the City of Soledad will abide by all requirements and provisions of the Roberti Z'berg-Harris Urban Open Space and Recreation Program.

Section 3. That the City of Soledad has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the projects funded under these applications.

Section 4. That the City of Soledad has or will have available, prior to commencement of the work on any of the projects identified in the applications, the required match.

Section 5. That the projects included in the applications conform to all the open space/recreation element of the General Plan of the City of Soledad.

Section 6. That the City Manager is authorized to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all requisite documents pertinent to the funding of the applications.

Section 7. That the City Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of the City to execute the certifications required of Legal Counsel by the State of California.

PASSED AND ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Soledad duly held on the 27th day of September, 1989, by the following vote:


