A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A "COOPERATIVE REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989/1990" WITH MISSION-SOLEDAD RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT




PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Soledad at a regular meeting duly held on the 24th day of January, 1990, by the following vote:

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the CITY OF SOLEDAD, a California municipal corporation, hereinafter called "CITY", and MISSION-SOLEDAD RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter called "DISTRICT" as follows:

RECITALS:

A CITY has a fire house and an established fire department. Said department operates four (4) fire trucks, owned jointly by CITY and DISTRICT, for the mutual benefit of both entities.

B The parties are now entering into this agreement for the purpose of setting forth their respective rights and obligations with respect to the use, operation and maintenance of said equipment.

AGREEMENT:

It is therefore mutually agreed by and between the said parties, as follows:

1. The term of this agreement shall be for one (1) year commencing January 1, 1990 and ending on December 31, 1990.

2. CITY shall keep all fire trucks belonging to CITY and the DISTRICT fully maintained and supplied with gasoline, oil and lubricants as needed, and shall keep said trucks repaired and provided with adequate tires.

3. CITY shall, during the term hereof, have the use of said trucks for the prevention and suppression of fires within the MISSION-SOLEDAD RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT. CITY agrees to furnish men and such other incidental equipment as may be necessary for said purposes. Decisions as to what particular item or items of equipment shall be used for said purposes shall at all times rest with the discretion of the appropriate official or officials of the fire department of the

CITY.

4 On or before December 1, 1990, an account shall be taken by the CITY'S finance director to determine the total cost of all fire department operations during the period from July 1, 1989 to and including June 30, 1990, as follows:

- (a) The cost of all normal fire department operations during said period; and
- (b) All extraordinary costs involved in responding to rural fire calls.

DISTRICT shall be provided with a copy of said account and shall have access to all pertinent CITY records for the purpose of verifying the accuracy of the same.

DISTRICT hereby agrees to pay to CITY, on or before December 31, 1990, an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of the normal costs referred to in subparagraph (a) above, and all of the extraordinary costs referred to in subparagraph (b) above.

5. DISTRICT currently is indebted to CITY in the sum of \$39,108.00 for its share of the cost of fire services provided to DISTRICT by CITY, the period from July 1, 1988 to and including June 30, 1989. DISTRICT hereby agrees to pay all monies owed to CITY on or before February 20, 1990.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said parties have caused these presents to be executed by their duly constituted agents as of the 24th day of January, 1990.
