

## RESOLUTION NO. 1968

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
SUPPORTING THE  
1990 CENSUS

WHEREAS, the decennial Census is the means this nation utilizes to determine the population of states and localities; and,

WHEREAS, more than fifty federal programs utilize Census data for allocation of federal funds; and,

WHEREAS, the decennial Census is the basis for reapportionment of federal, state and local offices; and,

WHEREAS, in 1980, the Census Bureau missed on percent of the general population and 5.9 percent of the Hispanic and Black populations; and,

WHEREAS, many residents failed to complete the Census questionnaire for fear that their residency would be disclosed; and,

WHEREAS, the Census Bureau is relying on the cooperation of state and local governments to assist in the promotion of the 1990 Census; and,

WHEREAS, Councilmember Manuel Campos has been appointed and has taken an active part in the activities of the Regional Complete Count Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Complete Count Committee has established a Community Assistance at 185 Encinal with the assistance of TRUCHA; and,

WHEREAS, The City Complete Count Committee has set up a neighborhood program of contacting all residents of the City to explain the need to participate in the 1990 Census.



PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Soledad at a regular meeting duly held on the 13th day of March, 1990, by the following vote:


