RESOLUTION NO. 1980

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF MAY AS
"OLDER AMERICANS MONTH"

WHEREAS, May is designated annually by the President and Congress as Older Americans Month, a time to recognize and honor older Americans as this nations' greatest untapped resource; and,

WHEREAS, 1990 is the Silver anniversary of the Older Americans Act which was signed into law July 14, 1965, and under the Older Americans Act, State and Area Agencies on Aging have been established to serve communities across the nation; and,

WHEREAS, 1990 is the Tenth Anniversary of the designation of the Monterey County Area Agency on Aging; and,

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Area Agency on Aging plays a significant role in meeting the challenges of Monterey County's aging society by developing and advocating for a coordinated, comprehensive system of services to assist older Americans maintain dignity and independence; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad recognizes that one of the most significant changes in the history of our nation is the unprecedented growth in our older population and this is affecting not only the way we live and work but the types of services, products, and housing we need; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has consistently shown a strong commitment to its senior citizens by supporting and developing programs to enhance the quality of life for the City's Older Americans, and,


