

## RESOLUTION NO. 2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
 COMMENDING FRANK JOHNSON ON THE OCCASION  
 OF HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SOLEDAD  
 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, for the greater part of a century the City of Soledad and the Mission-Soledad Rural Fire Protection District have been protected from the ravages of fire and other calamities by a group of public spirited individuals known collectively as the Soledad Volunteer Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Soledad firefighters represent and uphold the finest traditions of volunteer public service to one's neighbors and community; and,

WHEREAS, without the commitment and dedication of the Volunteer firefighters, the Soledad community and the surrounding rural environs could not benefit nor afford first class fire protection; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Soledad wish to honor those volunteer firefighters who after decades of service have retired from the Department's ranks.

WHEREAS, Frank Johnson, retired from the Volunteer Fire Department in September of 1988 having achieved the rank of Chief after 21 years of service.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD COMMEND FRANK JOHNSON FOR 21 YEARS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE AS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER AND HEREBY WISH FRANK AND HIS FAMILY GODSPEED AND GOOD HEALTH FOR MANY YEARS TO COME.
