

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
DECLARING THE WEEK OF APRIL 15TH - 21ST
"RECYCLE WEEK"

WHEREAS, it is vitally important that all residents of the City of Soledad support the City's and California's efforts to conserve natural resources, save energy and extend the life of landfills; and,

WHEREAS, all residents of the City of Soledad can continue to enjoy and help preserve the City's and California's natural beauty and abundant resources by participating in the citywide and statewide effort to recycle and reduce litter; and,

WHEREAS, California's beverage container recycling program include a refund value of five (5) cents for two (2) cans and bottles under twenty-four (24) ounces, and five (5) cents each for bottles larger than twenty-four (24) ounces; and,

WHEREAS, through this program and other waste reduction techniques being practiced in the community, California has become a leader in effective waste management and recycling; and,

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of complying with State law requirements for integrated waste management and is appointing a recycling committee to advise the Council, and,

WHEREAS, because more Californians and residents of the City of Soledad are returning their plastic and glass bottles and aluminum cans, our City and State are moving ever closer to the goal of recycling eighty (80) percent of all beverage containers.
