

## RESOLUTION NO. 2141

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
 DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY  
 DEMAND THE IMMEDIATE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC  
 FUNDS WITH REGARD TO THE SECOND FLOOR  
 OF 983 FRONT STREET

WHEREAS, on February 12, 1992, the two story masonry building located at 983 Front Street was the subject of a structure fire, and

WHEREAS, a report prepared by a registered Civil Engineer provided evidence that the second floor walls were not laterally supported and to be unreinforced, and

WHEREAS, the Building Official found the building to be an imminent health and safety hazard and ordered the owner to repair or abate the building immediately and revoked the occupancy of adjacent property, and

WHEREAS, the property owner waived all rights to appeal the notice to repair or abate and granted to the City the right to abate all hazards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Soledad that the Second Floor of 983 Front Street is an imminent danger to health and safety and that public health and safety demand the immediate expenditure of public money to safeguard life, health, or property.
