The following will constitute the agreement between Rodney J. Blonien on behalf of Whitman & Ransom (hereinafter "RJB") and the **City of Soledad** (herein "client") for the provision of legislative advocacy and consultation services.

The term of this contract shall commence on March 2, 1992. This contract may be modified at any time by mutual consent of the parties, but any modifications shall not become effective until reduced to writing and executed by the parties.

For those services specified herein, client shall pay, and RJB shall receive a fee not to exceed \$12,000 for necessary advocacy, legislative consulting services and reasonable expenses, payable in the amount of \$1,000.00 per month for twelve months.

The services and fees specified in this contract are as follows:

- A. The advocacy fee includes:
1. Consultation services with the Governor's Office, State Legislature and Department of Corrections.
 2. Reasonable consultation and providing of materials to state agencies and departments.

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
