

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION OF THE ASSOCIATION OF
MONTEREY BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS (AMBAG) FOR
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION/FEDERAL
TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE SECTION 8 FUNDS
AND TO COMMIT MATCHING MONEY

WHEREAS, the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) is eligible to apply to the State of California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) for Federal Transportation Assistance Section 8 grant funds; and

WHEREAS, AMBAG has applied for said grant funds to study the feasibility of providing intercity public transportation service between Salinas and the South Monterey County cities of Gonzales, Soledad, Greenfield and King City; and

WHEREAS, AMBAG has requested the City of Soledad provide two thousand dollars (\$2,000) as a portion of the local match required for said grant; and

WHEREAS, a South County Transit Feasibility Study Steering Committee composed of South County City Managers (or designees) and Monterey County Supervisor Perkins (or designee) shall be formed to guide the study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Soledad City Council does hereby support the application of the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments for CALTRANS/FTA Section 8 funds to study the feasibility of Salinas Valley Intercity public transportation and appropriates the requested matching amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).
