

RESOLUTION NO. 2209

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA
INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD FOR
DESIGNATING THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AS A PART OF THE CENTRAL
COAST RECYCLING MARKET
DEVELOPMENT ZONE

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 and companion legislation designed to promote recycling Development Zone for the State, and

WHEREAS, the success of statewide implementation of the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (AB-939) is post-consumer waste materials; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Benito, cities of Greenfield, Watsonville, Hollister, Soledad and others within that three county jurisdiction intend to make joint application for the formation of a Central Coast Recycling Market Development Zone (CCRMDZ); and

WHEREAS, the designation of a CCRMDZ dedicated to the expansion of secondary materials business enterprises will be beneficial for market development region wide; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad fully supports and desires to initiate steps to create a regional CCRMDZ; and

WHEREAS, the Counties of Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Benito, cities of Soledad, Greenfield, Watsonville, Hollister and other jurisdictions intend to form a Memorandum of Understanding supporting the cooperative efforts necessary to implement the CCRMDZ plan, and

WHEREAS, upon designation by the California Integrated Waste Management Board of the Recycling Market Development Zone, the City of Soledad will work to expand participation in the Zone to other interested local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously supported the application for zone designation as the Integrated Waste Management Task Force's began in June, 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Soledad Soledad that:

- 1) The current waste management practices and conditions in the City of Soledad are favorable to development of post-consumer waste materials markets


- 2) The designation of the proposed zone as a Recycling Market Development Zone is necessary to assist in the expansion of existing recycling businesses and in attracting new recycling business investments to the proposed zone.
