A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION
TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
A BICYCLE PROJECT GRANT (CORRECTIONAL
TRAINING FACILITY COMMUTER PATH)

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad recognizes that it is in
the interest of the local community to promote bicycle travel as
a major transportation mode,

WHEREAS, the Correctional Training Facility (CTF)
Commuter Path will provide benefits to the local community in
the form of improved traffic flow safety and convenience for
bicycle commuters commuting as a whole, and

WHEREAS, funds have been established and are available
through the California Transportation Commission for grants for
local agencies for bicycle projects

application to the California Transportation Commission for a
bicycle project grant.
