A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION
 TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
 FOR A BICYCLE PROJECT GRANT
 (NORTH STREET CORRIDOR)

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad recognizes that it is in the interest of the local community to promote bicycle travel as a major transportation mode,

WHEREAS, the North Street Corridor Development by the City of Soledad will provide benefits to the local community in the form of improved traffic flow safety and convenience for bicycle commuters commuting as a whole; and

WHEREAS, funds have been established and are available through the California Transportation Commission for grants for local agencies for bicycle projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad authorizes the City Manager to submit an application to the California Transportation Commission for a bicycle project grant.
