A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
COMMENDING WILLIE BROWN ON THE OCCASION OF HIS

WHEREAS, with the departure of "Willie", the City will lose a respected employee who will be remembered for his dedicated service and sacrifice to the City and its citizens.


