A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SOLEDAD PROCLAIMING  
APRIL AS CHILD ABUSE  
PREVENTION MONTH

BE IT HEREBY PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SOLEDAD

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect are serious problems  
that affect over two million children in the nation each year,  
and

WHEREAS, over 10,020 children in Monterey County were  
reported to be at risk for child abuse and neglect in 1992, and

WHEREAS, all children have a right to a childhood free  
of neglect, physical abuse, sexual molestation and exploitation,  
and,

WHEREAS, public and private agencies, schools medical  
facilities and community groups are working together to increase  
awareness of child abuse, decrease the incidence of child  
maltreatment, and coordinate services to assist the victims and  
their families, and

WHEREAS, the month of April, 1993 has been proclaimed  
Child Abuse Prevention Month in our nation to promote increased  
public awareness and support for prevention and intervention  
programs and to acknowledge the volunteers and professional who  
give of their time in prevention and intervention activities to  
help at risk children and their families


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council  
of the City of Soledad hereby proclaims the month of April, 1993  
as CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH and encourage all the citizens  
of the City of Soledad to support child abuse prevention  
activities in schools and communities throughout the County


