

RESOLUTION NO. 2246

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
SETTING THE MINIMUM BID FOR THE SALE OF
SURPLUS PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE
WATER TANK PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has, by Resolution,
declared a 30,000 square foot portion of the water tank property
surplus pursuant to City Council Resolution 2231; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has caused a real estate
appraisal be performed by Edward J. O'Conner a Certified General
Appraiser dated April 30, 1993 establishing the Fair Market Value
for the property at \$121,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council
establish a minimum bid for the sale of the property to be
\$121,000.
