

RESOLUTION NO. 2257

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING ITS PARTICIPATION IN A
UNIFICATION FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, on August 24, 1992, by Minute Order, the Soledad City Council announced its intention to participate in a study by the Soledad Union School District to explore the feasibility of a unified Kindergarten through 12 grade district for the purpose of constructing a High School; and

WHEREAS, Soledad Union School District has expressed its desire to proceed with the above referenced study and has indicated total cost will not exceed \$20,000 and one-half of the study's cost will not exceed \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Soledad that accurate and reliable information concerning unification be made available to its citizens.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Soledad authorizes its participation in a unification feasibility study to be conducted by the Soledad Union School District and shall contribute one-half of the study's cost up to a not to exceed amount of \$10,000.
