

RESOLUTION NO. 2299

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD ACCEPTING A BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,185, FROM LANDY ELECTRIC OF SALINAS, CALIFORNIA TO FURNISH AND INSTALL GENERATOR TRANSFER SWITCH, BATTERY CHARGE/BLOCK HEATER LINE AND RELATED HARDWARE

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has accepted bids for the installation of a generator transfer switch, battery charge/block heater line and related hardware (per attached documentation); and,

WHEREAS, the bid in the amount of Eight Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$8,185) from Landy Electric, was the lowest most responsible bid submitted for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD DOES HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1. That the bid in the amount of \$8,185 submitted by Landy Electric of Salinas California is hereby declared the lowest most responsible bid.
