

RESOLUTION NO. 2310

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
SETTING THE FAIR MARKET VALUE AND MINIMUM BID
FOR THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY KNOWN
AS THE WATER TANK PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad by Resolution No. 2231 declared surplus, a 30,000 square foot portion of the water tank property.

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad had a real estate appraisal prepared for the property by Edward J. O'Conner, a Certified General Appraiser, dated April 30, 1993 establishing the Fair Market value for the property at \$120,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council establishes the Fair Market Value and minimum bid for the sale of the property to be \$120,000.
