CITY OF SOLEDAD**



Dear Ray:

Per your request to Will Coddington, the following is our Not To Exceed proposal for surveying and mapping the City's sewer system.

1. Field surveys:

Check depths of all manholes, determine rim elevation of all manholes and measure horizontal distance between manholes. We will perform this work on a time and materials basis per our contract. For estimating purposes I have used an estimated count of 193 manholes and 36 cleanouts and allowed 40 minutes per manhole. Any manholes that are uncovered and/or with rusted frame and covers shall be uncovered/opened by City forces prior to being surveyed by our survey crew.

Estimated fee.....\$ 18,320

2. Map sheets:

Prepare maps of the mains at a scale of 1"= 200'. Showing existing invert and rim elevations, pipe size and slopes and manhole numbers.

Estimated fee.....\$ 3,500

TASK ORDER FOR JOB NO. 942374

and HANNA AND BRUNETTI
AUTHORIZATION OF SERVICES

1. Purpose:

The purpose of this TASK ORDER is to authorize and direct the ENGINEER to proceed with the work specific in Item 2 of this TASK ORDER, in accordance with the provisions of Article A and B of that AGREEMENT between the parties hereto dated July 24, 1991.

2. Scope of Work:

The work is designated "Special Projects" and is the sole responsibility and sole liability of HANNA AND BRUNETTI. The work authorized by this TASK ORDER is outlined in the "Scope of Services" attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

3. Time of Performance:

The work authorized by this TASK ORDER shall be completed within eight (8) weeks from the date of execution of this TASK ORDER

4. Compensation and Payment:

Compensation shall be on a time and material basis for all manholes and cleanout surveys and mapping of the City as described in Task A & B as provided in Article D of the AGREEMENT. The total time and material amount shall be at the hourly rate schedule in the Schedule of Charges, with a Not To Exceed amount of \$21,820.00. Payment shall be in accordance with Article D of the aforementioned AGREEMENT.

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6. Incorporation

All items and conditions contained in the ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT dated July 24, 1991 between the CITY OF SOLEDAD and HANNA AND BRUNETTI are incorporated herein by reference.

TASK ORDER FOR JOB NO 942374
SCOPE OF SERVICES
SANITARY SEWER MANHOLE SURVEY

The City of Soledad has critical need for accurate information of it's sanitary sewer system. There is no existing mapping showing horizontal and vertical information. This survey will provide that information.

This TASK ORDER will include the following work:

TASK A - SURVEYS

HANNA & BRUNETTI will collect the existing sewer system information for mapping purposes. The work will consist of:

1. **Field surveys:**
Check depths of all sewer manholes, determine rim elevation and measure horizontal distance between manholes. We will perform this work on a time and materials basis per our contract. For estimating purposes I have used an estimated count of 193 manholes and 36 cleanouts and allowed 40 minutes per manhole. Any manholes that are covered and/or with rusted frame and covers shall be uncovered/opened by City forces prior to being surveyed by our survey crew.

TASK B - ENGINEERING

HANNA & BRUNETTI will prepare maps for the following items:

1. **Map sheets:**
Prepare base maps of the sewer mains at a scale of 1"= 200' showing existing manhole invert and rim elevations, assign manhole identification numbers, and pipe sizes and slopes.

TASK C - PROJECT MANAGEMENT

HANNA & BRUNETTI will provide project management to efficiently perform the project work and to maintain close liaison with the

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SERVICES NOT INCLUDED

This TASK ORDER does not include the following tasks:

1. Geotechnical Engineering - including test borings, sampling and analysis, soils reports and recommendations, and materials testing.
2. Land surveys, establishment of boundaries and monuments, preparation of easement descriptions, and related computations and drawings and/or engineering and topographical surveys for design and construction
3. Coordination with the other agencies
4. Preparation of detailed applications and supporting documents for government grants or advances for public works projects.
5. Preparation of environmental assessment and impact statements and other assistance to the City in connection with public hearings.
6. Master planning beyond the immediate project or assessment of the completed project's ability to meet the ultimate larger area's design intent relative to capacity, maintainability, operability, or reliability.

The above tasks will be submitted as a separate TASK ORDERS.

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
