

RESOLUTION NO. 2361**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING SHARING OF COST (80% CDC, 20% CITY)
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOLEDAD AND THE CALIFORNIA
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR REMOVAL OF
SLUDGE FROM CITY'S WASTEWATER PONDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad and the State Department of Corrections (CDC) have entered into a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) for the expansion of the City's Wastewater Treatment Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the CDC has prepared documents and advertised for the receipt of bids for the expansion of the City's Wastewater Treatment Facilities; and

WHEREAS, sludge must be removed from City's wastewater pond areas before expansion construction can proceed; and

WHEREAS, the manner of payment for the City's share of cost in removing the sludge is prescribed under the terms and conditions of the JPA between the City and CDC.

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the City's twenty percent (20%) share for the cost of removing pre-construction sludge will be \$15,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that sharing the costs removing pre-construction sludge from the existing City wastewater treatment ponds is authorized pursuant to the terms of the existing JPA between the City of Soledad and the Department of Corrections.
