

RESOLUTION NO. 2372

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED UNIFICATION OF THE
SOLEDAD UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad, after holding public hearings and receiving public testimony, adopted a General Plan Update on August 1993, establishing goals and policies related to the development and planning of schools for the citizens and students of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City's General Plan Land Use Element contains a specific implementation program stating, "The City of Soledad shall encourage the Soledad Unified School District and the Gonzales Union High School District to continue to explore the viability of district unification"; and

WHEREAS, the City's General Plan Land Use Element contains a specific implementation program stating, "The City of Soledad shall encourage the formation of a unified kindergarten through 12th grade district to serve Soledad, and the construction of a full High School in Soledad"; and

WHEREAS, the City has worked diligently with the School Districts to provide appropriate mitigation and land dedications for school sites in the Andalucia and Vista Soledad developments; and


WHEREAS, the City of Soledad on July 12, 1993, adopted Resolution No. 2257 authorizing the City's participation in a unification feasibility study with the contribution of up to \$10,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Soledad hereby endorses and supports the proposed unification of the Soledad Union School District (K - 12).
