

RESOLUTION NO. 2375

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED ON MONTEREY AND EIGHTH STREETS BETWEEN SEVENTH AND EIGHTH STREETS TO "15 MILES PER HOUR" AND ESTABLISH A "NO PARKING" AREA ON THE SOUTH WESTERN SIDE OF THE MONTEREY AND EIGHTH STREET TRANSITION

WHEREAS, City Code Section 10.04.050 and Chapter 10.04, provides for the establishment of Speed Limits and "No Parking" areas by Resolution of the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed modifications to the traffic controls devices has been reviewed by the City Engineer and City Staff indicating the proposed modifications are consistent with State standards; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed and approved the submittal of a General Plan Consistency Report on September 1, 1994 for the proposed modifications to the Traffic Control Devices on Monterey between Eighth and Seventh Streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby approve as follows:

- 1. Establish a maximum speed of "15 Miles Per Hour" on Monterey Street between Seventh and Eighth Streets (Transition).
2. Establish "No Parking" areas on the southwest side of the Monterey and Eighth Street Transition.
