

RESOLUTION NO 2409

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD REQUESTING FULL MITIGATION OF IMPACTS FROM PROPOSED EMERGENCY BED PROGRAM AT SOLEDAD CORRECTIONAL TRAINING FACILITY

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Corrections is proposing the establishment of a total of 1,020 emergency beds for housing at the Soledad Correctional Training Facilities (Soledad I and Soledad II); and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Corrections has prepared and certified an Environmental Impact Report for the expansion of the existing facility (Soledad II), that established a Mitigation Monitoring Program, along with siting specific impacts on local jurisdictions (schools and municipalities); and

WHEREAS, Michael Brandman Associates, consultants for the California Department of Correction have contacted the City and School District concerning preparation of a mitigated Negative Declaration for the proposed first stage of the emergency bed program (600 beds); and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 10 provides for possible full mitigation of impacts to local jurisdictions.

BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Soledad requests that the State Department of Corrections provide full mitigation of impacts from the proposed 1,020 Emergency Bed Program at Soledad Correctional Training Facility, to the City of Soledad and the Soledad Union School District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City requests that monetary mitigation measures be distributed directly to City of Soledad and the Soledad Union School District.
