

RESOLUTION NO 2423

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPOINTING THE CITY ENGINEER AS THE CITY'S AGENT AND
THE CITY MANAGER AND ACCOUNTANT AS ALTERNATE
AGENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILING CLAIMS
WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA)**

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad, along with Monterey County was declared a disaster area by the Governor Wilson of California per FEMA Guidelines (Disaster Number FEMA-1046); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad on March 11, 1995, adopted Resolution No 2419, declaring an emergency due to flooding; and

WHEREAS, FEMA Guidelines require that the City designate, by resolution, an agent and two alternates per the Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council appoints the City Engineer as the City's Agent and the City Manager and Accountant as alternates pursuant to FEMA Guidelines.
