RESOLUTION NO. 2425

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
ORDERING THE REORGANIZATION (ANNEXATION) OF THE VISTA  
SOLEDAD REORGANIZATION INVOLVING THE ANNEXATION  
OF 205+/- ACRES INTO THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
AND DETACHMENT OF THE SAME FROM THE  
GABILAN-SANTA LUCIA RESOURCE  
CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND  
MISSION-SOLEDAD RURAL  
FIRE PROTECTION  
DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of Monterey County adopted Resolution 95-05 on February 28, 1995 making its determinations and approving the proposed annexation to the City of Soledad of territory described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad has received certified copies of LAFCO Resolution 95-05 as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code; and conditions were applied to the approval; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad has initiated annexation proceedings pursuant to Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act, Section 56800 of the State of California Government Code, for a reorganization of the territory consisting of the annexation of approximate 205+/- acres of vacant land to the City of Soledad and detachment of the same from the Gabilan-Santa Lucia Conservation District and the Mission-Soledad Rural Fire Protection District; and

**WHEREAS**, the affected territory will not be taxed for existing general bond indebtedness of the City of Soledad; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Monterey County LAFCO has designated the City of Soledad as the conducting authority and the City Council has been directed to initiate reorganization proceedings without public notice, public hearing or election; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad and Monterey County have adopted Resolutions dividing the property taxes generated from the sites; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad and Monterey County have adopted Resolutions for entering into an agreement on the sharing of affordable housing units developed in the area; and,

**WHEREAS**, one hundred percent (100%) of the property owners consented to the annexation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the principal property owners have requested annexation to the City of Soledad in order to develop the Vista Soledad development; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad has (on August 8, 1995) adopted

Resolution No. 2367, "Certifying as Adequate the Final Environmental Impact Report for Vista Soledad",

Resolution No 2368, "Requesting Reorganization/Annexation of the Vista Soledad Development";

Resolution No 2369, "Approving the Vista Soledad Community Tentative Subdivision Map";

Resolution No. 2370, "Approving a Mitigation Monitoring Program for the Annexation of Project Areas 1 and 2 of the Vista Soledad Community Subdivision";

Ordinance No 539, "Requesting the Monterey County LAFCo to Initiate Proceedings to Approve the Proposed Vista Soledad Community Reorganization Involving the Annexation and Detachment of the Same from Gabilan-Santa Lucia Resource Conservation District and the Mission-Soledad Rural Fire Protection District


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city Council of the City of Soledad that it hereby orders the territory described in "Exhibit B" reorganizing (annexing) the 205+/- acres, known as the Vista Soledad Reorganization/Annexation and directs the City Clerk of the City of Soledad to transmit a certified copy of this resolution with the applicable information required by law to the Executive Officer of the Monterey County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo).

RESOLUTION OF THE MONTEREY COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION  
COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE PROPOSED "VISTA  
SOLEDAD REORGANIZATION," INVOLVING ANNEXATION OF 205± ACRES TO THE  
CITY OF SOLEDAD AND DETACHMENTS FROM THE GABILAN-SANTA LUCIA  
RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE MISSION SOLEDAD RURAL FIRE  
PROTECTION DISTRICT**

RESOLVED, by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Monterey, State of California, that

WHEREAS, a resolution for the proposed "Vista Soledad Reorganization" involving annexation of 205± acres to the City of Soledad and detachments from the Gabilan-Santa Lucia Resource Conservation District and the Mission Soledad Rural Fire Protection District, in the County of Monterey, were heretofore filed and accepted for filing by the Executive Office of this Local Agency Formation Commission, pursuant to Title 6, Division 1, commencing with Section 56000, et seq of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer, pursuant to Government Code Section 56828, set February 28, 1995 as the hearing date on this proposal and gave the required notice of hearing, and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time and place specified in said notice of hearing and in any order or orders continuing such hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer, pursuant to Government Code Section 56833, has reviewed this proposal and prepared a report, including recommendations thereon, and has furnished a copy of this report to each person entitled to a copy, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to the satisfaction of this Commission that the owners of land included in the proposal consent to this reorganization; and

WHEREAS, this Commission, on February 28, 1995, heard from interested parties, considered the proposal and the report of the Executive Officer and considered the factors determined by the Commission to be relevant to this proposal, including, but not limited to, factors specified in Government Code Section 56841, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has read and considered the final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the proposed "Vista Soledad Community" certified by the City of Soledad on August 8, 1994; Addendum No 1 to the EIR approved by the City on October 10, 1994, Addendum No 2 to the EIR approved by the City on January 9, 1995, and the Mitigation Monitoring Plan approved by the City on August 8, 1994 in consideration of the "Vista Soledad Reorganization"

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Monterey does HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

Section 1. The Commission considered the impacts presented in the EIR and Addenda and found that all the significant impacts due to project implementation could be reduced to less than significant levels with the implementation of mitigation measures proposed, with the exception of the potential cumulative loss of agricultural land, the overdraft of the Salinas Valley groundwater basin, and overcrowding of schools

Section 2. The Commission finds that the aforementioned environmental impacts are significant impacts that cannot be reduced to a less than significant level with mitigation and are, therefore, subject to a Statement of Overriding Considerations. The Commission adopts the following findings to support the Statement of Overriding Considerations:

- a. It is the intent of State Housing Law that local governments must provide opportunity for the construction of housing suitable to satisfy all segments of the community. The City's Sphere of Influence supports urbanization and related housing development within the City of Soledad and, therefore, demonstrates intent to cooperate with the City's growth and expansion objectives.

Evidence: California Government Code Section 65581(d)  
City of Soledad Sphere of Influence adopted  
February 22, 1994.

- b. The implementation of the project contemplated under the final EIR will result in the addition of up to 730 residential units to the City's housing stock. The implementation of the project will fulfill important City of Soledad goals and policies by providing additional housing opportunities within City limits.

Evidence. Housing Element of the City of Soledad General Plan;  
Vista Soledad Community Environmental Impact Report  
certified by the City of Soledad August 8, 1994.

- c. Development of the proposal area will help to implement the City of Soledad's growth strategy to improve the economic health of the City. The proposal will provide additional residential opportunities consistent with the City's Sphere of Influence to accommodate the projected housing demand generated by the Soledad Correctional Training Facility and the Dole agricultural processing plant

Evidence. The Final Environmental Impact Report for the General Plan Update certified by the City of Soledad on  
July 26, 1993

Section 3. LAFCO considered a number of alternatives to the proposed project identified and evaluated in the Environmental Impact Report for the "Vista Soledad Reorganization", including "No Project", "Reduced Density" and "Change in Land Use" alternatives. The "No Project" alternative may be

environmentally superior, but was rejected based on the following information.

- a The adopted Sphere of Influence for the City of Soledad and the "Urban Reserve" designation of the Central Salinas Valley Area Plan indicate that the area is appropriate for urbanization.

Evidence. The City of Soledad Sphere of Influence as amended by LAFCO on February 22, 1994

- b The "No Project" alternative would reduce affordable housing opportunities for existing and future residents of Soledad

Evidence. The Vista Soledad Community Environmental Impact Report certified by the City on August 8, 1994.

Section 4. Said proposal is approved subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter specified

Section 5. The boundaries of the territory proposed to be reorganized are hereby approved as described in Exhibit "A", "B" and "C" attached hereto and made a part hereof. Said territory is said to be uninhabited, and is assigned the following distinctive short form designation: "Vista Soledad Reorganization"

Section 6. Any resolution ordering such reorganization shall provide that such reorganization shall be made subject to the following specified terms and conditions.

- a That a certificate of completion be filed on that portion of the reorganized territory known as Stage 2, shown on Exhibit "B", just prior to the time of filing of a final subdivision map on Stage 2 by the City of Soledad, and
- b. That a certificate of completion be filed on that portion of the reorganized territory known as Stage 3, shown on Exhibit "C", just prior to the time of filing of a final subdivision map on Stage 3 by the City of Soledad.

Section 7. The City of Soledad is designated as the conducting authority, and the legislative body is hereby directed to initiate reorganization proceedings without notice, hearing, and without election.

Section 8. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution in the manner and as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code
