**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
 APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN ALTERNATIVE
 APPLICATION FOR PROPOSITION 172 FUNDS
 FOR THE SCHOOL RESOURCE PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the voters of the State of California adopted Proposition 172 to provide additional funding for emergency services at the local level; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the City of Soledad has applied and received funding from Proposition 172 funding for the D A.R.E. and the Canine Program; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors through its Public Safety Committee has solicited requests from local jurisdictions for possible funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad is in need of continuing and expanding its present School Resource Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad Police Department has existing D.A.R.E. and G.R.E.A.T. Programs to serve both the youth and residents of the City of Soledad, improving community programs in crime reduction


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council approves the submittal of a backup alternative application for Proposition 172 funding for the School Resource Programs
