**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
RECOGNIZING AND HONORING LINDA J. CLARKE ON HER
APPOINTMENT AS WARDEN OF THE SOLEDAD
CORRECTIONAL TRAINING FACILITY**

WHEREAS, the Soledad Correctional Training Facility was established in 1946. During this time period, the facility has become a significant part of the Soledad community; and

WHEREAS, Linda J. Clarke has served with California Department of Correction for twenty-eight years and began her career as a Supervisor I at the California Rehabilitation Center at Norco, California; and

WHEREAS, Linda has served with distinction as a Correctional Supervisor, Correctional Sergeant, Correctional Lieutenant, Correctional Counselor II, Program Administrator, Associate Warden and Chief Deputy Warden at several institutions; and

WHEREAS, Linda was appointed Warden of the Soledad Correctional Training Facility on April 1, 1995. Her confirmation was approved by the California State Senate on April 1, 1996; the first woman to serve as Warden in the facility's 50 year history.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby commend and honor LINDA J. CLARKE on her steadfast work for the State of California Department of Corrections and her State Senate confirmation as Warden of the Soledad Correctional Training Facility.
