ENDORING THE CITY OF SOLEDAD'S 75TH ANNIVERSARY
DIAMOND JUBILEE SPONSORSHIP OF THE 4TH OF JULY
FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND FESTIVITIES AS AN
ACTIVITY BENEFITTING THE COMMUNITY**

WHEREAS, the City has expressed its desire to hold a one time, special Fourth of July event to help commemorate the City of Soledad's 75th Birthday; and

WHEREAS, the "Diamond Jubilee Committee," an Ad Hoc non-profit group of citizens, business persons and civic leaders, organized to oversee the City's year-long celebration of its 75th Anniversary; and

WHEREAS, said festivities (public entertainment, food booths, children's games and baseball games) will require the use of Gallardo Park, Rotary Park and the Little League Park; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide safe access to all activities, Andalucia Street will be closed off at Metz Road and Ticino Street, as well as Walker Drive at Metz Road and Granada Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fireworks display and festivities have been deemed as an enjoyable and appropriate means of celebrating the City's 75th Anniversary, which will furnish the additional benefit of providing members of the community with a safe City-controlled alternative to the individual illegal discharge of specific types of fireworks with the City limits.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to direct staff to provide reasonable assistance and support for the "4th of July Fireworks Display and Festivities," and other activities sponsored by the Diamond Jubilee Committee, as long as such efforts comply with City policies, rules and regulations and to not require the expenditure of unbudgeted City funds. Any request contrary to City policies, or rules and regulations, or requiring the expenditure of City funds, shall be brought before the City Council for due consideration
