

RESOLUTION NO. 3650

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR HOME
INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM FUNDS TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (the Department) is authorized to allocate HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Home funds are to be used for the purposes set forth in Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, in federal implementing regulations set forth in Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 92, and in Title 25 of the California Code of regulations commencing with section 8200; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2005 the Department issued a 2005 Notice of Funding Availability announcing the availability of funds under the HOME program (NOFA), and

WHEREAS, in response to the 2005 NOFA, the City of Soledad wishes to apply to the Department for and receive an allocation of HOME funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Council

- 1 In response to the 2005 NOFA by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application to the Department in the HOME Program and for an allocation not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) for the following activities and/or programs. Demolition of approximately 36 units of existing farm labor housing and reconstruction of 73 new units of farm labor housing for the Soledad Housing Authority to be located on Benito Street; and
2. If the application for funding is approved, then the applicant hereby agrees to use the HOME funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in its application as approved by the Department in accordance with the statutes and regulations cited above, any amendments thereto, and any and all other documents or instruments necessary or required by the Department or HUD for participation in the HOME program.


