

RESOLUTION NO 3656

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL DECLARING SURPLUS EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE, DONATION, OR DISPOSAL OF SUCH PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Government State Code Section 37350 - 37351 provides for the ability of cities to dispose of property for the common benefit of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has accumulated material that is either obsolete, outdated or is no longer of use to the City and thus is considered surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the value, obsolescence and condition of these items make it impractical to trade the same on future purchases of new inventory items, and to obtain the maximum return for said surplus items, it should be in the best interest of the City to dispose of the same in a manner that will no longer be to the best advantage to the City of Soledad, and

WHEREAS, the City has an estimated 350 water meters which Staff is recommending that the Council surplus and direct staff to sale such property

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows.

- 1 Based upon the findings and recommendations of the City, the water meters belonging to said City are declared surplus to the foreseeable needs of the City
2. That it is deemed to be for the common benefit of the residents of said City to dispose of said inventory


