

RESOLUTION NO. 3664

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
ACCEPTING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TOLEDO
STREET RE-ALIGNMENT PROJECT FROM MONTEREY PENINSULA
ENGINEERING**

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2004, the City Council awarded Monterey Peninsula Engineering the contract for construction of the Toledo Street Re-Alignment Project; and

WHEREAS, Mark Thomas & Co has reported to the City that the improvements in the field have been completed in accordance with the approved improvement plans and City of Soledad Standards and Specifications; and

WHEREAS, all of the construction engineering components of the project, such as field design changes, project management after notice to proceed through completion of engineer acceptance letter, site inspections, inspection documentation, material verification of both quality and quantity, quality assurance, any requisite contract change orders during construction, final inspection punch list, final inspection and engineer acceptance letter have been submitted to the Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends that the City accept the Project as complete, thereby authorizing the issuance of the formal notice of completion and release of Project bonding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby accept certain improvements associated with the Toledo Street Re-Alignment Project from Monterey Peninsula Engineering.


