

RESOLUTION NO. 3672

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD DECLINING TO JOIN THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY IN APPLYING FOR DESIGNATION AS A DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ENTITLEMENT JURISDICTION

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has invited the County of Monterey to apply for designation as a Department of Housing and Urban Development Entitlement Jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the designation would require the County of Monterey to enter into cooperative agreements with cities representing at least 200,000 population and 50% +1 of the targeted income population of the County; and

WHEREAS, County Staff met with staff members of several cities to discuss the proposed funding levels and it appears the consensus is that the Cities and the County would receive less funding than under the existing State Grant competitive process, and

WHEREAS, County Staff is considering recommending that the Board of Supervisors direct its staff not to pursue designation as a HUD Entitlement Jurisdiction at this time

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Council hereby declines to join the County of Monterey in applying for designation as a Department of Housing and Urban Development Entitlement Jurisdiction at this time.


