

**RESOLUTION NO. 3679**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
APPROVING THE 2004 SOLEDAD GENERAL PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad has caused to be prepared a comprehensive revision of the General Plan in accordance with California Government Code Section 65350 which is incorporated herein by this reference as though set forth in its entirety; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 11, and September 8, 2005 the Planning Commission conducted a duly noticed public hearing to consider the draft General Plan and considered all public comments received, including the staff report, and has recommended approval, and

**WHEREAS**, on September 21, 2005 the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing to consider the draft General Plan and considered all public comments received including the staff report and the Planning Commission's recommendation, and

**WHEREAS**, the City has caused to be prepared a final environmental impact report ("FEIR") for the 2004 General Plan and Wastewater Treatment and Disposal Master Plan in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq ) and related Guidelines (Title 14 California Code of Regulations, Section 15000 et seq ), and the City's rules and procedures for the implementation of CEQA, and

**WHEREAS**, the FEIR, which responds to related concerns raised during the public review period and at the public hearings, has been prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq ) and related Guidelines (Title 14 California Code of Regulations, Section 15000 et seq ), and the City's rules and procedures for the implementation of CEQA, and

**WHEREAS**, the FEIR has been circulated for public review and comment for 45 days in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq ) and related Guidelines (Title 14 California Code of Regulations, Section 15000 et seq ), and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has, by way of separate resolution, certified the FEIR as being complete, and has adopted a related statement of overriding considerations, and hereby further finds and certifies that the information contained in the FEIR has been reviewed and considered by the Soledad City Council in considering the adoption of the 2004 General Plan, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the draft General Plan complies with all applicable City plans, codes and standards.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Soledad hereby approves the 2004 General Plan based upon the findings set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.



## **Exhibit A – Findings**

- 1 The 2004 General Plan satisfies the relevant provisions of California Government Code Sections 65000 et seq
