

RESOLUTION NO. 3940

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE SECOND CYCLE OF GRANT FUNDING FOR NON-PROFIT
AGENCIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006-07 PURSUANT TO CITY POLICY NO. 480**

WHEREAS, City Policy No. 480, adopted by the City Council on June 7, 2000, and amended several times thereafter, established the process by which non-profit organizations may request and the City may grant funds for programs or activities which benefit the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council appropriated \$23,500 in the Fiscal Year 2006-07 Budget for City Council Non-Profit Grants; and

WHEREAS, the City duly complied with the provisions of Policy No. 480 by advertising and otherwise notifying non-profit entities of the availability of such funding grants; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2007 and January 29, 2007, a subcommittee consisting of two Council members reviewed all applications and made recommendations with respect to appropriate grant awards; and

WHEREAS, funds will be released to the non-profit agency after compliance with Policy No. 480; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now wishes to act on said recommendations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows:

1. The City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of and adopts the recommendation of the City Council Grant Subcommittee for Grants in Fiscal Year 2006-07 totaling \$16,500 and authorizes the following grant awards to the entities and in the amounts hereafter indicated:


